

RESOLUTION NO. 2015-05-14-01 (WASHINGTON PIKE –VANADIUM ROAD)

A RESOLUTION OF THE COLLIER TOWNSHIP MUNICIPAL AUTHORITY AGREEING
TO ACCEPT OWNERSHIP AND MAINTENANCE OF CERTAIN SANITARY SEWERS
AND MANHOLES AS INSTALLED AND CONSTRUCTED IN AND ALONG
WASHINGTON PIKE AND VANADIUM ROAD AREAS OF COLLIER TOWNSHIP

WHEREAS, the Collier Township Municipal Authority (CTMA) has awarded a contract to construct certain line extensions or line improvement along Vanadium Road and Washington Pike and now desires to formally accept ownership and maintenance of these two lines; and,

WHEREAS, field observations of construction of the additional sanitary sewer lines were performed by NIRA Consulting Engineers, Inc. on behalf of the Collier Township Municipal Authority; and

WHEREAS, NIRA Consulting Engineers, Inc. has advised the Collier Township Municipal Authority that final inspection and testing of the sanitary sewer lines within the Vanadium Road and Washington Pike are complete; and,

WHEREAS, the sanitary sewer lines and manholes passed the required air and vacuum tests and passed the necessary deflection (mandrel) test; and,

WHEREAS, NIRA Consulting Engineers, Inc. recommended that the sewer lines listed in the attached exhibit sheets be accepted by the Collier Township Municipal Authority; and,

WHEREAS, The contractor for this project now has provided to the Collier Township Municipal Authority its certification as to the construction cost of the said lines which were constructed at a construction cost of \$26,336.00 for the Vanadium Road area line and \$37,702.00 for

the Washington Pike lateral connection, and;

WHEREAS the contractor has arranged to post with the Collier Township Municipal Authority a maintenance bond in the amount of fifteen (15%) percent of the construction costs and said bond is for a period of eighteen months from the date of the completion and acceptance of the work.

NOW THEREFORE, the Collier Township Municipal Authority at a publicly held meeting on the 8th day of January, 2015.

1. Reviewed this Resolution, and formerly adopted the Resolution, accepting ownership and control of the sanitary sewer lines and manholes listed as follows:

Washington Pike area:

72 lineal feet of 6”diameter SDR-26 PVC, 66 lineal feet of 12” diameter steel casing, and one connection to existing sliplined sewer main using a 7” x6” fabricated HDPE reducing tee.

Vanadium Road area:

125 lineal feet of existing 8” diameter VCP lined with cured in place liner, one 4”diameter precast concrete manhole, and approximately 6 lineal feet of 6” diameter SDR-35 PVC

2. The lines are hereby accepted as an Authority sanitary sewer system now and into the future.
3. This Resolution of acceptance of the public improvement shall be maintained as part of the records of the Collier Township Municipal Authority and a copy shall be delivered to the contractor that have agreed to the issuance and delivery of said


maintenance bond as required above, to the Collier Township Municipal Authority.

Adopted this 14th day of May, 2015, after review and by a majority vote of the members of the Collier Township Municipal Authority.
