

**RESOLUTION NO. 7-10-2014- 01
(HILLTOP ROAD SANITARY SEWER PHASE 1)**

A RESOLUTION OF THE COLLIER TOWNSHIP MUNICIPAL AUTHORITY AGREEING
TO ACCEPT OWNERSHIP OF CERTAIN SANITARY SEWERS AND MANHOLES AS
INSTALLED AND CONSTRUCTED IN AND THROUGH HILLTOP ROAD SANITARY
SEWER PHASE 1

WHEREAS, the Collier Township Municipal Authority (CTMA) as project developer, has caused to be constructed, certain sanitary sewers, manholes and associated main line components in and through the Hilltop Road Sanitary Sewer Phase 1; and,

WHEREAS, CTMA determined that it was necessary to cause the construction of this phase due to the extreme lack of property depth to the rear yards of three dwellings located along Hilltop road and the fact that Maronda Homes, Inc. was, as is, in the process of construction a major residential project which lot abutted the rear property line of three house, and;

WHEREAS, the three existing dwelling had old failing septic system which systems drained or leached to the surface and created a health hazard, and;

WHEREAS, CTMA authorized the construction as part of a benefits assessment project as the construction provided public sewers only for the use and benefit of three dwellings that had no other economical way to correct their septic systems, and;

WHEREAS, CTMA, after securing public bids for the project awarded the necessary contracts for the construction and installation of the system by and through Strnisha Excavating Inc., and;

WHEREAS, field observations of construction of sanitary sewers and manholes were performed by NIRA Consulting Engineers, Inc. on behalf of the Collier Township Municipal Authority; and

WHEREAS, NIRA Consulting Engineers, Inc., has advised the Collier Township Municipal Authority that final inspection and testing of the sanitary sewer lines within Hilltop Road Sanitary Sewer Phase 1 are complete; and,

WHEREAS, the sanitary sewer lines and manholes y have passed the required air and vacuum tests and passed the necessary deflection (mandrel) test; and,

WHEREAS, NIRA Consulting Engineers, Inc. recommended that the sewer lines listed herein be accepted by the Collier Township Municipal Authority; and,

WHEREAS, Strnisha Excavating, Inc. now has provided to the Collier Township Municipal Authority its certification as to the construction cost of the said lines which were constructed at a construction cost of Thirty Seven Thousand Three Hundred Twenty Nine and no\100 Dollars (\$37,329.00); and,

WHEREAS Strnisha Excavating, Inc. has caused to be posted in favor of the Collier Township Municipal Authority a maintenance bond in the amount of One Hundred percent (100%) of the construction costs of the project as required by the contract and the procedures of the Authority.

NOW THEREFORE, the Collier Township Municipal Authority at a publicly held meeting on the 10th day of July, 2014.


1. Reviewed this Resolution, and formerly adopted the Resolution, accepting ownership and control of the sanitary sewer lines and manholes here after listed as of the date of this Resolution:

Six Hundred Seven (607) lineal feet of 8" diameter SDR-35 main line pipe, three (3) 8" x 8"x 6" PVC wye connections, 45 lineal feet of 6" SDR-35 PVC lateral pipe and three (3) 48" diameter precast concrete manholes.


2. These lines and manholes hereby accepted are in and through Hilltop Road Sanitary Sewer Phase 1, as part of the Authority sanitary sewer system now and into the future.
3. This Resolution of acceptance of these public improvements shall be maintained as part of the records of the Collier Township Municipal Authority and a copy shall be delivered to Strnisha Excavating, Inc.
4. The Authority is directed to prepare and send certified mail notices to the three properties served by this project, which is a benefit assessed construction project, to file the required application to connect and to disconnect from their private on lot systems and connect to this public sanitary sewer extension which was constructed to benefit the properties served.

Adopted this 10th day of July, 2014, by a majority vote of the members of the Collier Township Municipal Authority.
