

RESOLUTION 11-14-2013-01

**A RESOLUTION OF THE COLLIER TOWNSHIP MUNICIPAL AUTHORITY
AUTHORIZING AND APPROVING THE HILLTOP ROAD PHASE 1 SANITARY
SEWER EXTENSION; APPROVING THE ISSUANCE OF A CONTRACT FOR
CONSTRUCTION OF THE PROJECT AND AUTHORIZING THE FILING OF A
PETITION FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF A BOARD OF VIEW TO ASSESS
BENEFITS AGAINST THE PROPERTIES SERVED AND BENEFITED BY THE
CONSTRUCTION OF SANITARY SEWERS TO SERVE THE PROPERTIES.**

WHEREAS, it is required for the general welfare of the residents of the Township of Collier, and it being the duty and obligation of the Municipal Authority to provide sanitary sewage with the Township of Collier; and,

WHEREAS, the Collier Township Municipal Authority, in order to provide for the development of the Township and to prevent health hazards, has been determined that it is necessary to eliminate existing septic tanks and provide sanitary sewage service to the area to be identified as Hilltop Road Phase1 Extension Project area; and,

WHEREAS, certain plans and specifications are on file in the office of the Authority for the construction of a line extension through portions of a Maronda Homes plan known as Tuscan Ridge so as to provide sanitary sewer service to three (3) existing residential dwellings that are located between Hilltop Road and the rear lot lines of lots of the Tuscan Ridge existing development and will allow for the elimination of septic tanks currently servicing these existing dwellings; and,

WHEREAS, this project will only serve and is only for the benefit of properties identified as:

- 2663 Hilltop Road also known as Parcel 0329-H-00002,
- 2669 Hilltop Road also known as Parcel 0329-H-00001,
- 2657 Hilltop Road also known as Parcel 0329-H-00003

WHEREAS, this project phase is being constructed at this time so as to reduce future project costs since the Tuscan Ridge lots are vacant and not developed and the lots have not been landscaped at this time; and,

WHEREAS, the project was placed for bid by advertisement and was open to public bidding and on the recommendation of the consulting engineer a construction bid, representing the lowest bid from a qualified contractor, of Thirty Seven Thousand Three Hundred Twenty Nine (\$37,329.00) Dollars was publically accepted on October 10, 2013 and a construction contract was awarded to Strnisha Excavation, Inc. for the construction of these lines; and,

WHEREAS, the Collier Township Municipal Authority also on October 10, 2013 determined that the project is currently being constructed and is determined to be a project only for the benefit of these several properties and further directed that, upon completion of the project, a Petition for the Appointment of a Board of View be prepared and filed requesting that a Board of Viewers view the properties and determine the amount of benefit each received because of this municipal improvement and access each property for the costs of construction of this public improvement.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved:

1. That this sewer construction project serves and benefits these three properties and allows each to eliminate septic tanks that have or will fail and are currently discharging from the septic fields into the lands and waterways of the Township of Collier and are a danger to the health and safety of the area.
2. That the proper representatives of the Collier Township Municipal Authority are authorized and directed to prepare a Petition for the appointment of a Board of View and to take all necessary steps to present to a Board of View all necessary plans, records and cost estimates to allow the Board of View to benefit assess each property as allowed under the Municipal Authorities Act.


3. That no Notice of Taking, is required to obtain the necessary right-of-ways within the Township of Collier, as the Collier Township Municipal Authority previously acquired the needed right-of way to allow for these properties to be served.
