

RESOLUTION NO. 2015-08-13-01 (BOYS HOME LINE EXTENSION)

A RESOLUTION OF THE COLLIER TOWNSHIP MUNICIPAL AUTHORITY AGREEING TO ACCEPT OWNERSHIP AND MAINTENANCE OF CERTAIN SANITARY SEWERS AND MANHOLES AS INSTALLED AND CONSTRUCTED AS PART OF THE STEEN HOLLOW SANITARY SEWER EXTENSION AND A SUB EXTENSION COMMONLY KNOW AS THE BECCARI EXTENSION WITH THE PROJECT BEING ALSO REFERRED TO AS THE BOY HOME EXTENSION IN COLLIER TOWNSHIP

WHEREAS, the Collier Township Municipal Authority (CTMA) entered into an agreement with the Municipal Authority of the Township of South Fayette (MATSF) to awarded a contract to construct certain line extensions or line improvement along to the Steen Hollow Sanitary Sewer Line which was jointly constructed by CTMA and MATSF so as to extend the line into South Fayette and allow for the elimination of the Boys Home pump station which serviced MATSF and now CTMA desires to formally accept ownership and future maintenance of the lines constructed in the CTMA service area; and,

WHEREAS, field observations of construction of the additional sanitary sewer lines with in the CTMA service area were performed by NIRA Consulting Engineers, Inc. on behalf of the Collier Township Municipal Authority; and

WHEREAS, NIRA Consulting Engineers, Inc. has advised the Collier Township Municipal Authority that final inspection and testing of the sanitary sewer lines herein identified as the Steen Hollow Sanitary Sewer Extension and the Beccari Extension are complete; and,

WHEREAS, the sanitary sewer lines and manholes passed the required air and vacuum tests

and passed the necessary deflection (mandrel) test; and,

WHEREAS, NIRA Consulting Engineers, Inc. recommended that the sewer lines listed in the attached exhibit sheets be accepted by the Collier Township Municipal Authority; and,

WHEREAS, MATSF issued the construction contract and was reimbursed by CTMA for the CTMA line extension costs as set forth in the agreement by the parties and the Beccari line extension was at the cost of the property owner and constructed at his request and at his expense, and;

WHEREAS the MATSF under the contract has arranged for the maintenance bond requirements for the main line and Beccari has posted a cash bond with the Collier Township Municipal Authority with said cash maintenance bond in the amount of fifteen (15%) percent of the construction costs of the Beccari section with said bond is for a period of eighteen months from the date of the completion and acceptance of the work.

NOW THEREFORE, the Collier Township Municipal Authority at a publicly held meeting on the 13^h day of August, 2015.

1. Reviewed this Resolution, and formerly adopted the Resolution, accepting ownership and control of the sanitary sewer lines and manholes listed as follows:

Steen Hollow Sanitary Sewer Extension:

2072 lineal feet of 8”diameter SDR-35 PVC main line pipe, (13) 48”diameter precast concrete manholes, (2) 8” x 6 PVC wye fittings and 20 lineal feet of 6”diameter SDR-35 lateral pipe.


Beccari Extension:

79 lineal feet of 8”diameter SDR-35 PVC main line pipe, (1) 48”diameter precast concrete manhole, 38 lineal feet of 16” diameter x 0.25” wall steel casing.


2. The lines are hereby accepted as an Authority sanitary sewer system now and into the future.
3. This Resolution of acceptance of the public improvement shall be maintained as part of the records of the Collier Township Municipal Authority and a copy shall be delivered to Beccari and MATSF for their records.
